Your child learned about organ, eye and tissue donation and transplantation in class today. Every person applying for a driver's license or identification card in Oklahoma has the opportunity to choose whether or not they would like to register as a donor.

The goals of this lesson were:

- To educate students about organ, eye and tissue donation and how transplants saves lives.
- To provide students with basic information for making an informed decision as to whether they want to register to be a donor.
- To encourage students to discuss this important topic with their parent or guardian.

Please take some time as a family to discuss this issue and review any information your child brings home. Ask your child about some of the things they learned about donation. Even though it may feel uncomfortable, a family discussion about organ, eye and tissue donation now could someday make a decision about donation easier for your family. Many families faced with this decision have shared it was a relief to know their loved one's feelings about donation.
