

Lesson Plan

Understanding Organ, Eye and Tissue Donation

Objective:

This lesson plan is designed to introduce the student to the topic of organ, eye and tissue donation in preparation for being asked to join the Oklahoma Donor Registry when they apply for their driver's license. You have the ability to decide how this topic best fits into your curriculum.

Time: 45 minutes
